Toyota had the highest automaker revenue of \$258 billion, up 8%.

Revenue is not final earnings for automakers. Revenue reveals the total amount of money earned before operating costs are deducted.

Foreign currencies were converted to US dollars using exchange rates from each automaker's fiscal year end date.
